



LARE Candidate Review Session

The WIASLA will be offering an **LARE Candidate Review Session on Saturday August 21, 2010.** As you may be aware, the exam's sections have been substantially changed after the latest CLARB Task Analysis; in addition, the cost of the exam continues to escalate.

If you or someone in your office is planning to begin the licensing process or already taken some of the exam sections, then consider registering for this hands-on review. It has been our experience that such a review can mean the difference between passing exam sections the first time through or retaking them a number of times.

The review session we offer is up-to-date and relates to the spectrum of issues one might encounter on the exam. The main issue stressed in this review is not so much knowing material as it is understanding and applying the process in the appropriate manner.
