
Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded: one to a current sophomore student and one current junior student enrolled in the UW-Landscape Architecture program.

Using the same site, create one **after image** of the site. Write a **narrative** to explain what you chose to change on site and why.

- Answering the questions above
- Creativity and/or Innovation
- Personalization
- Health, Safety, & Welfare of the Public
- Comprehensible by the General Public

Images must be created by the applicant and may be created via any media you choose; however, they must be digitized and provided with your submittal as an $8.5"\times11"$ 300 ppi jpg or pdf.

Each narrative is limited to 280 characters or less, excluding spaces. No glyphs or emojis allowed.

All scholarship forms must be submitted as a high resolution PDF. Images must be submitted as high resolution jpg or pdf.
